Jerry, I was surprised to receive the attached letter. My comment concerning the EA was directed at what I regarded as a need to disclose the flooding associated with raising the level of Tina Lake to the height it had been when the standpipe was installed.

I believe that raising the lake level will have ecologically beneficial impacts, and my understanding is that this is also the position of the resource agencies. The main landowner at the south end of the lake is unhappy in any case; he had hoped that Dowling would go in where the right-of-way currently exists; this would have increased the value of his land. Raising the water level to the level possible with the original standpipe will likely adversely affect the current condition of his land.
