The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF), in cooperation with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), proposes to widen and extend Dowling Road in the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska. The proposed improvements for the build alternative: extend Dowling Road from B Street to Minnesota Drive, widen Dowling Road to **5 4-lanes (4 travel lanes and a median turn lane)** between the Old Seward Highway and B Street, replace the bridge over Campbell Creek, create a grade-separated crossing of the Alaska Railroad tracks near Arctic Boulevard, and upgrade the drainage in Tina Lake.

This project is part of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program. The total cost to construct the project is expected to be approximately \$77.5 million.
